Attendance of museums and galleries.

The purpose of this report is to summarize data about the attendance of museums and galleries and to suggest ways to increase it.

Since 2013 the amount of visitors of most museums and galleries has increased, but the ones that introduced admission charges in 2014 received less visits in 2015 than in 2013. It means that people find these museums and galleries less appealing than ones without charges.

For example, since 2013 up to 2015 the amount of visits to British Museum changed from 2,6 mln to 5,1 mln and to Natural History Museum - from 3,7 mln to 1,6 mln. The ~~enormous~~ enormous difference was caused by the introduction of admission charges.
