In October 2014 students of our school were offered a free trial of "Computer Based Games for English Learners", produced by the ABC Company. We have asked some of the students to participate in this experiment and are now presenting the results.

Trial Participants.

For this experiment we have chosen students from form 10 and form 11. Trial participants included 40 students from form 10, creating 4 groups of 10 people, and 30 students from form 11, creating 3 groups of 10 people.

Trial Conditions

We have provided students with different working conditions. Students from form 10 worked in class with the teacher while students from form 11 worked individually after classes without the teacher.

Themes and Types of Exercises.

Students from form 10 used the product to learn new material in Grammar, for example, Sequence of Tenses, Indirect Questions, Modal Verbs and Articles. They worked with Fill in the gaps exercises only.

Students from form 11 used the product to drill learned material in Vocabulary, for example, Idioms, Phrasal Verbs, Synonyms and Antonyms. They worked with Multiple Choice exercises only.

Results of the Experiment

Both forms demonstrated better knowledge of English at the end of the experiment, and their test results became better. But the students had mixed opinions on the product, as students from form 10 found the tasks exciting while students from form 11 found the tasks boring.
