The influence of specific computer games on study results

- A series of language computer games was proposed to the students of our school in October 2014 by the ABC company in order to investigate their impact on learning English. p.
- Two large groups of students (40 in form 10 and 30 in form 11) took part in the experiment. The conditions were different for the two groups: firstly, ten-graders were to complete the tasks in class in presence of a teacher, while eleven-graders were to do them individually in their free time. The nature of the tasks themselves differed as well: students in form 10 were given grammar tasks on new topics (Sequence of Tenses, Indirect Questions etc) while the other group was mostly to revise familiar material (Idioms, Phrasal Verbs etc.) The exercises were given in different forms: filling the gaps for ten-graders and multiple choice for those in grade 11. The outcome turned out to be positive: according to the test results, both groups have shown progress. However, the students' opinions on the subject are not identical: students in form 10 had shown an interest in the games, whereas students in form 11 hadn't. This difference in the assessments is understandable. Firstly, the eleven-graders had to exercise in familiar topics. Secondly, they had to sacrifice their spare time to do the tasks. voc.
- The problem could be resolved in several ways. More different types of tasks ~~might~~ and a larger variety of topics might be introduced to prevent monotonous work, and making the games more competitive might encourage students to make more effort playing them. voc.
- Although overall analysis shows that the experiment has had a positive influence on the students, several improvements might be ~~introduced~~ brought in in order to increase the efficiency of the method. voc.
