As students of our school we are deeply concerned with the state of our museum. A research has been carried out in order to find the reasons for school museum's lack of popularity.

Our school museum is situated in the basement and it possesses a number of different objects and sources of information, including photos of the previous students, first history books, medals, helmets and even the first headmaster's engagement ring.

Despite having a lot to exhibit and show the students, the museum is not used effectively by the students. Our research has shown why it is so rarely visited. Firstly, 80% of the students are unaware of the school museum and its collections. Secondly, those who do know about the museum do not find it entertaining or resourceful, as the objects are not sorted or placed in order, thus it is nearly impossible to find the needed information.

As for recommendations, there are some we would like to point out. Secondly, school authorities should advertise the museum among the students, as few of them know about it. However, it is crucial that the museum's facilities are upgraded before the advertisement, as the students may find the museum boring and unwelcoming as it is now.

To sum up, we believe that, if the authorities follow our advice, the museum has all the chances to become popular and to be used by students on a daily basis.
